This month, we are going to make Daifuku: 大福 (sticky rice cake). It is one of the most popular traditional Japanese desserts. Daifuku's outer layer is made of Mochi: 餅 It is stuffed with sweetened red or white bean paste. In modern times many different fillings are available including pleasant fruit flavours. (We are going to use strawberry this time) Daifuku in Japanese literally means “Big luck”. As such it has also become synonymous with wishing good luck in Japan and thus has become as a popular traditional gift. Classes are for beginners of Japanese cooking. Bring your apron, hair cover and indoor shoes.
