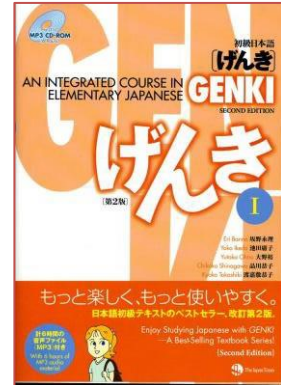


## EJCA Japanese Language Program

EJCA has been offering Japanese Language classes since 2009. There are three sessions per year and each session has three classes, one each for

1. Total Beginners
2. Intermediate Beginners
3. Advanced Beginners

In the fall of 2014, EJCA Culture Programs reviewed our achievements of the last five years and decided to offer more structured programs using a new textbook called “Genki げんき”. Genki is one of the most recently released textbooks and has been used in Japanese classes at the University of Alberta and McEwan University. The new curriculum has been used since September 2015.



The plan for a one year cycle is:

Beginner Intermediate	「Genki 1」 Chapters 3 and 4	「Genki 1」 Chapters 5 and 6	「Genki 1」 Chapters 7 and 8
Beginner Advanced	「Genki 1」 Review of Chapter 8 Chapter 9	「Genki 1」 Chapter 10	「Genki 1」 Chapter 11, if possible include Chapter 12

\*All classes will include discussion of Japanese culture, conversation and other topics in addition to using the textbooks.

Anyone who has Japanese Language learning experience may start lessons in an appropriate class at any time. At the end of the Term 3, students will decide with feedback from instructors, which level they will go to in the next Term 1.

Each term has 10 two-hour lessons on Wednesdays 7:00 – 9:00 pm. The tuition fee is \$105/term plus cost of a textbook if you are a new student.
